## intituled

An Act to amend the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952.

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Malaysia as follows:

### Short title

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Act 2013.

#### Amendment of section 31A

- **2.** The Dangerous Drugs Act 1952 [Act 234], which is referred to as the "principal Act" in this Act, is amended in section 31A by inserting after subsection (1A) the following subsection:
  - "(1AA) Any biological sample collected for the purposes of an examination under this section may be analysed by a science officer employed by the Government.".

# Renumbering of section 37A

**3.** The principal Act is amended by renumbering the existing section 37A as section 37B.

### New section 37A

**4.** The principal Act is amended by inserting before section 37B as renumbered the following section:

## "Application of presumptions

**37A.** Notwithstanding anything under any written law or rule of law, a presumption may be applied under this Part in addition to or in conjunction with any other presumption provided under this Part or any other written law.".

### **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

This Bill seeks to amend the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952 ("Act 234").

- 2. Clause 1 contains the short title of the proposed Act.
- 3. Clause 2 seeks to introduce a new subsection (1AA) into section 31A of Act 234 to provide for a science officer employed by the Government to be allowed to analyse any biological sample collected for the purpose of examination under that section. Where a class of such science officers are declared by a notification published in the Gazette under subsection 399(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code as a class of persons to whom subsection 399(1) of the same Code applies, the document purporting to be a report under the hand of such science officer may be given in evidence in a trial of an offence under Act 234.
- 4. Clause 3 seeks to renumber the existing section 37A as section 37B.
- 5. Clause 4 seeks to introduce a new section 37A into Act 234 to allow the Public Prosecutor to apply a presumption provided under Act 234 in addition to or in conjunction with any other presumption provided under Act 234 or any other written law.

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS
